IEST – What is it?

It appears that we crossed a big hurdle when the Central Government allocated money in its latest budget for converting BESU into an IEST. We hope that the West Bengal Government will not pay any attention to the delaying tactics of a section of employees who are raising new and contentious issues and want the issues to be resolved before the school is handed over to the Central Government. However, it is our belief that they will come to senses & not try to delay the conversion process further. It has been a long time since we started our campaign and BESU will be IEST sooner or later with or without anymore distractions.

As only a few have been involved in the conversion of BESU to an Institute of National Importance (INI) and ultimately a national institution, most of the alums, including GAABESU, EC members and Pls, are not quite sure about IEST status vis a vis IITs, IISc and NITs. Some alums even made snide remarks that BESU will be upgraded to NIT without realizing that it is utterly nonsense.

The Anandakrishnan Committee that recommended BESU as the top candidate for conversion to INI, had different thoughts. They knew that IITs, despite being good undergraduate institutions, have not been able to fulfill the national needs for research and development. Accordingly, they came up with the idea of creating a new type of national institution. This new category of institutions, what they were planning to call "Advanced Institutes of Technology", was to develop international institutions geared towards graduate study and research. For this, the basic degree will be Masters after attending 5-year integrated program. The students who are interested in graduate study, will be selected through a national competitive admission process as well as from neighboring countries.

On learning the mission of these new category of institutes, some of us suggested calling them "All India Institute of Science and Technology" (in line with AIIMS), as they appear to be a combination of the best of IITs (teaching) and IISc (research); the committee probably agreed with the logic and slightly modified the name to "Indian Institute of Engineering Science and Technology".

Like IITs, the faculty will be chosen on a national basis. The original idea was to select the students similarly, but due to the objections from West Bengal Government, a compromise was reached to have 50% of the students from Bengal and rest from other states. Because of this provision, Central Government decided to use NIT bill to convert BESU to IEST.

It is obvious from above that if everything works out, our school will be able to compete not only with the best national institutions but also with other top institutions in Asia. Our grand old college will regain its lost glory. Let the entire BESU community join hands without paying attention to personal interests to help the administration make our Alma Mater, the best institute for engineering and science education in India, again.

Annual Convocation at BESU, Shibpur

12th convocation was held on February 16, 2010. Professor Kaushik Basu, Chief Economic Adviser, Government of India graced the event as Chief Guest. A renowned economist, Prof. Basu serves Cornell University as the C. Marks Professor of Economics.



In the convocation, 874 students received their diplomas. Of these, 24 students received PhD, 200 received ME, 27 received MCA, 106 received MSc, 112 received MBA, 405 students received BE and 16 students received BArch degrees.
