Applicant should provide Phones, emails, websites of the social groups or projects where applicant’s social leadership and activities can be verified to establish applicant’s eligibility for the award. Applicants can submit any additional proof of social work/Leadership roles to increase the chance of winning the award. Members of the Award committee will physically/remotely verify the actual social works and roles of individual applicants based on provided information and documents. Based on physical verifications of the claim, Award committee will submit the reports to the selection committee for final selection. This will strictly be administered to select the genuine candidates for the award. Applicant’s active role and participation are the main criteria for selection if individual applicant is a member of national/international social work organization
Selection Process	All interested students shall collect application form from GAABESU Office and submit it before due date. Short listed candidates will be interviewed by the Interview Team. Based on the evaluations of the Interview Team recommendations will be sent to the Donors for final selection / approval.

Eligibility/Minimum Requirements:

- The applicant must be a current IEST undergraduate student with good academic record. Each AFE applicant should have scored CGPA 8.0 and above, for last two semesters in IEST. However this criteria may be relaxed in exceptional cases (e.g., excellent sports performance, outstanding extra curricular activities, etc.).
- No disciplinary action had been taken against the applicant in IEST.
- AFE is awarded on a yearly basis. Should any applicant already received AFE in the previous year, GAABESU will consider his/her achievement is already recognized. Therefore other applicants will get preference. However this is not applicable if any recipient is applying for another category of AFE.
- Applicants shall meet read and understood all other requirements of AFE programme as per published process document (see link below):

- **PLEDGE:** All award recipients need to give a signed pledge to GAABESU that:

“On graduation from IEST, I shall join GAABESU as a life member. After my graduation, my caution money deposited with IEST administration shall be transferred to GAABESU as first the instalment of my membership fee. I shall pay up the rest of my life membership fee as & when they are due, as notified by GAABESU”.

In case this pledge is not submitted by the student, it shall automatically lead to rejection of the award.
